
The Muses

 - Christopher Park redevelopment in District C


Site Location

- Bounded by Florida Ave., Mazant St., N. Dorgenois St., Alvar St., Law St., and Gallier St.






Neighborhood Improvements







- Bike racks and shelters throughout

Covered bike racks to protect bikes from the elements. Locks to be provided by tenants.




*Plans taken from another LDG property with in-unit extra storage. Florida Ave. could have a similar interior layout, but with a larger New Orleans-style porch.











Next Steps







2 Elevation - Side - Left
