2023 N. Robertson

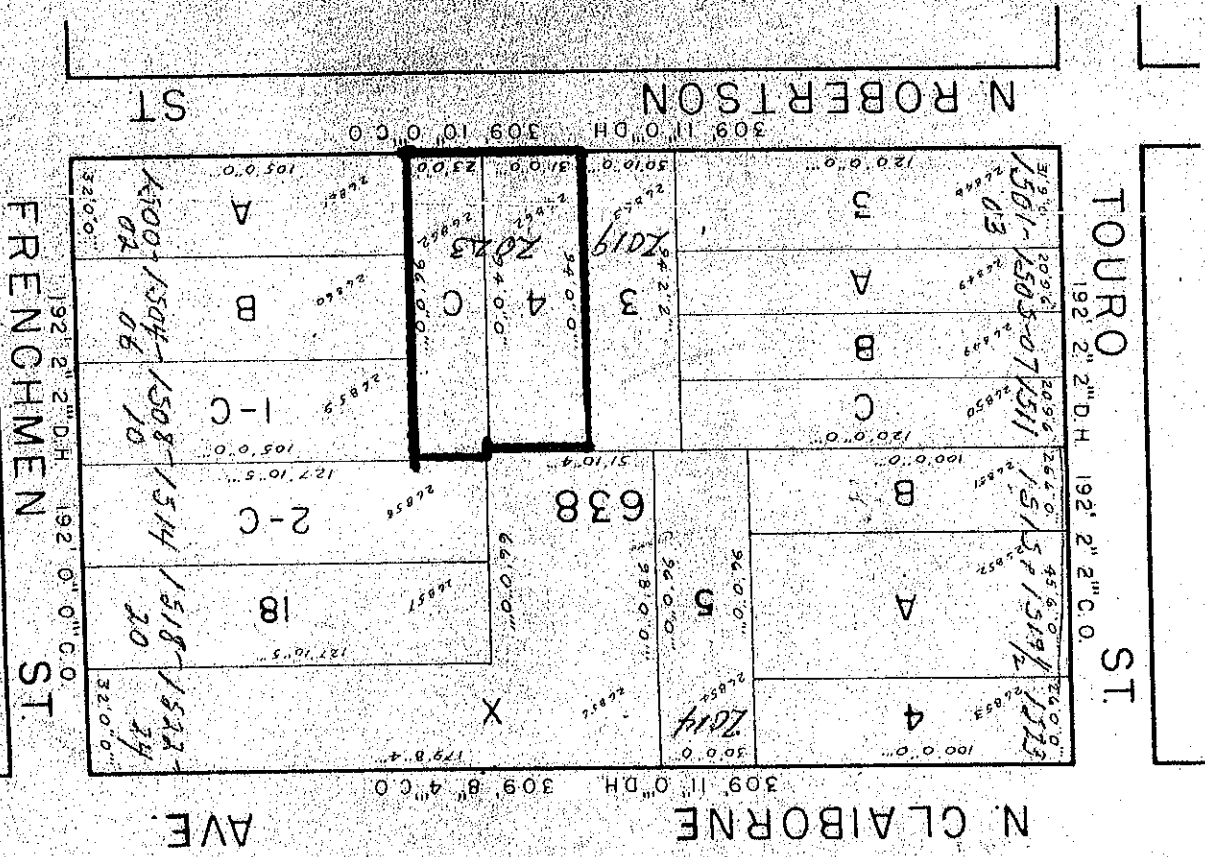
A CERTAIN LOT OF GROUND, together with all the buildings and improvements thereon and all the rights, ways, privileges, servitudes and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, situated in the Third District of this City, in Square No. 638, bounded by Frenchmen, Touro and N. Robertson Streets and Claiborne Avenue, designated as Lot No. 4 according to a plan by Walter J. Seghers, D.C.S., dated June 9, 1919, found in file in record No. 127,092 entitled Succession of Mrs. Louise Knorpp, widow of John Bonnacase, said lot measures 31 feet front on N. Robertson St., by 94 feet in depth between parallel lines.

A CERTAIN LOT OF GROUND together with all the buildings and improvements thereon, and all the rights, ways, privileges, servitudes and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, situated and adjoining the above described Lot No. 4, designated in said sketch as Lot C and measuring 23 feet front on N. Robertson St., by a depth of 96 feet between parallel lines.

The improvements are designated as No. 2023 N. Robertson Street being the same property acquired by Eugene W. Harleaux from Succession of Ferdinand J. Duplantier, et al, by act before Charles Schwartz, Jr., N.P., dated December 29, 1969, in COB 697, folio 123.

Further being the same property in which Roland J. Barbarin acquired an undivided $\frac{1}{2}$ interest from Eugene W. Harleaux by act before Charles Schwartz, Jr., N.P., dated December 31, 1969, registered in COB 697, Folio 126.
