

THREE CERTAIN LOTS OF GROUND, situated in the Third District of the City of New Orleans, designated by the numbers one, two and three, on a sketch drawn by C. Uncas Lewis, dated March 1899, and annexed for reference to an act passed in this office on the 30th day of May, 1899, said lot measures as follows, to-wit: (Lot No. one forms the corner of North Robertson and Benton Streets, and measures thirty feet (30') front on Benton Street, by one hundred and twenty feet (120') in depth; (Lots Nos. two and three measure each thirty feet (30') front on Benton Street, by one hundred and twenty feet (120') in depth. All of said lots being in Square 686 bounded by North Claiborne, Benton, Gordon and North Robertson Streets and being a portion of the same property acquired by the predecessor from D. F. Watts, et al, by an act of sale before Fernand Kernan, N.P., April 25, 1899, and recorded in COB 171, folio 362.

Being the same property acquired by Ernest P. Proctor from Octave Valentine, Jr., et al, by act before Lawrence L. Lagarde, Jr., N.P., dated January 23, 1969, registered in COB 691, folio 24.
