A CERTAIN LOT OF GROUND, together with all the buildings and improvements thereon, and all the rights, ways, privileges, servitudes, appurtenances and advantages thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, situated in the City of New Orleans in the Third District, in Square 822, bounded by Tupelo, N. Roman, N. Derbigny Streets and St. Maurice Avenue; and, according to a survey by H. O. Landry, dated October 17, 1952, and registered in COB 592, folio 74, the said lot is designated by the letter "K" and forms a corner of Tupelo and N. Roman Streets and measures thence 47 feet front on N. Roman Street same width in the rear, by a depth between equal and parallel lines and frontage on Tupelo Street of 128 feet. According to a survey by Gilbert, Kelly and Couturie, dated November 15, 1969 a copy of which is annexed to an act before Melvin J. Duran, Notary Public, dated December 23, 1969.
