WHAT IS KEDILA YOUTHBUILD?

KEDILA YOUTHBUILD (KYB) is a community-based pre-apprenticeship program funded by the U.S. Department of Labor, that provides job training and educational opportunities for young adults, ages 16 - 24, who have previously dropped out of high school. With KYB, young adults learn vocational skills in construction and provide community service through the construction or rehabilitation of affordable housing for low-income or homeless families in our City. Participants split their time between the vocational training work site and the classroom, where they earn their high school equivalency diploma, learn to be leaders, and prepare for postsecondary training opportunities including college, apprenticeships and employment. Kedila YouthBuild also provides significant support, such as mentoring, barrier assistance, follow-up, personal counseling services and participation in civic engagement.

Kedila YouthBuild may be a good fit for you if...

- You have dropped out of school or need remedial educational assistance
- You are a member of any ethnic group and/or nationality and are able to read, write and speak English
- You would like to earn a “Ca\$h Allowance” while you learn



You are eligible to enroll if...

- You are a resident of the Greater New Orleans area
- You are between the ages of 16 to 24
- You are eligible to work in the United States
- You are a current or former foster young adult
- You are a young adult offender
- You are a young adult with a disability
- You are a legal, documented immigrant, migrant farm worker youth or young adult
- You are a child of an incarcerated parent
- You are a low-income young adult
- To enroll in the Kedila YouthBuild program you need:



- State-issued Photo ID
- Birth Certificate
- Social Security Card
- Document of Barrier listed above
