THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners hereby acknowledges and confirms that Gregg Fortner, the Executive Director of HANO, shall perform the duties of Contracting Officer to be carried out in accordance with all applicable policies, procedures, laws, and regulations governing HANO.

Additionally, the Board is authorized to arrange or contract for the furnishing by any person or agency, public or private, of services, privileges, works, or facilities for or in connection with its developments or the occupants thereof.

HANO's Board of Commissioners may delegate to one or more of its agents or employees such powers and duties as it may deem proper.
