RESOLUTION NO. 2021-13

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of New Orleans (HANO) owns and operates Fischer IV and IVA, a Housing Community consisting of 103 mixed-income rental housing units; and

WHEREAS, HANO has confirmed that 101 of the 103 rental units that comprise the Fischer IV and IVA Housing Community require corrective work to the flooring and other interior/exterior repairs; and

WHEREAS, HANO has divided the interior/exterior repairs at all 101 of the Fischer IV and IVA units into five phases; and

WHEREAS, HANO issued five invitations for bid – IFB #21-912-28 for Phase 1; IFB #21-912-29 for Phase 2; IFB #21-912-30 for Phase 3; IFB #21-912-31 for Phase 4; and IFB #21-912-32 for Phase 5 – on May 21, 2021 for the performance of the corrective work at 101 of the 103 Fischer IV and IVA units; and

WHEREAS, in response to IFB #21-912-29 for Phase 2 (23 units), HANO received four (4) bids on June 21, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the lowest, responsive, responsible bid to IFB #21-912-29 for Phase 2 was received from Legacy Restoration and Referral; and

WHEREAS, Legacy Restoration and Referral submitted evidence of their commitment to comply with HANO's requirements relative to subcontracting opportunities for DBE/WBE and Section 3 Businesses and hiring opportunities for Section 3 individuals; and

WHEREAS, the HANO Procurement Department has completed its due diligence verification for Legacy Restoration and Referral and determined they are responsible; and

WHEREAS, the HANO Finance Department has certified there is sufficient funding to perform corrective work to the 23 units that comprise Phase 2 of the Fischer IV and IVA repairs; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of the Housing Authority of New Orleans hereby approves the award of a contract for Phase 2 of the Fischer IV and IVA repairs, and authorizes the and authorizes the Executive Director, Evette Hester, to execute a contract with Legacy Restoration and Referral for Phase 2 of the Fischer IV and IVA repairs (23 units) in an amount not to exceed \$1,045,000.00 pursuant to Invitation for Bids #21-912-29.

Re: Award of Contract-IFB #21-912-29-Phase 2-Corrective Flooring and Interior
and Exterior Repairs to 23 Units at Fischer IV and IVA Housing Community

The Fischer IV and IVA Housing Community is a mixed-income, HANO-owned property located on the Westbank of Orleans Parish.

Per the request of Asset Management, the Modernization Department has solicited contractors to perform corrective flooring work as well as other interior and exterior repairs to 101 of the 103 rental units at the Fischer IV and IVA community. The 101 units to be fixed grouped in a total of five (5) construction phases consisting of 19 units in Phase 1; 23 units in Phase 2; 23 units in Phase 3; 19 units in Phase 4; and 17 units in Phase 5 that will be worked on simultaneously.

In accordance with all applicable Federal and State regulations and laws as well as HANO's procurement policy, five invitations for bid were issued to perform the interior and exterior repairs on all five groups – IFB #21-912-28 (for Phase 1), IFB #21-912-29 (for Phase 2), IFB #21-912-30 (for Phase 3), IFB #21-912-31 (for Phase 4), and IFB #21-912-32 (for Phase 5) – and all five IFBs were issued and advertised on May 21, 2021. All bids received in response to these IFBs were opened on Monday, June 21, 2021.

For IFB #21-912-29 - Phase 2, HANO received four (4) bids that ranged from \$789,150.00 to \$2,046,176.00. The contract duration for IFB #21-912-29 - Phase 2 is 280 days.

The apparent low bid was \$789,150.00, from Rock Enterprises Construction who withdrew their bid due to a calculation error. Of the remaining three (3) bids Legacy Restoration and Referral, whose bid was \$1,045,000.00, proved to be the lowest, responsive and responsible bidder IFB #21-912-29 - Phase 2. HANO's in-house cost estimate for the Construction Block/Phase 2 was approximately \$1.1 million.

HANO requests that the Board of Commissioners approve the award of a contract and authorize the Executive Director, Evette Hester, to execute a contract with Legacy Restoration and Referral to perform the corrective work to the flooring and interior/exterior repairs to the twenty-three (23) rental units in Construction Block/Phase 2 at Fischer IV and IVA Housing Community in an amount not to exceed \$1,045,000.00 pursuant to Invitation for Bids #21-912-29.
