THREE CERTAIN LOTS OF GROUND, together with all the buildings and improvements thereon, and all the rights, ways, privileges, appurtenances and advantages thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, situated in the City of New Orleans, in the Third District, in Square No. 835, bounded by Gordon, North Roman, Benton and North Prieur Streets, designated as Lots Nos. 1, 2, and 3 which lots adjoin and measure as follows:

Lot 1 forms the corner of Gordon and North Roman Streets, measuring thirty-four feet two inches and four lines (34'2"4"') on Gordon Street, by one hundred twenty-six feet four inches two lines (126'4"2"') in depth and front on North Roman Street, and the same depth on the opposite side. Lots Nos. 2 and 3 measure each thirty (30') feet front on Gordon Street the same width in the rear, by one hundred twenty-six feet, four inches, two lines (126'4"2"') in depth.

According to three (3) surveys of Gilbert, Kelly & Couturie, Sur., dated November 20, 1970, redated January 10, 1970, and November 17, 1970, copies of which are annexed hereto, said lots have the same designation, location and measurements as hereinabove set forth. Lot No. 2 commences at a distance of 34 feet 2 inches 4 lines from the corner of Gordon Street and N. Roman Street. Lot No. 1 commences at a distance of 64 feet 2 inches 4 lines from the corner of Gordon Street and N. Roman Street.

The improvements on Lot No. 1 bears Municipal No. ~~1804-06~~ Gordon Street. The improvements on Lot No. 2 bear Municipal No. 1804-06 Gordon Street. The improvements on Lot No. 3 bear Municipal No. 1808-10 Gordon Street.

Being the same property acquired by Rudolph J. Barnes by three separate acts from First Homestead and Savings Association by act before Melvin J. Duran, Notary Public, dated October 23, 1969, registered in COB 693, folio 628.
