



## **Studio, One, Two, Three, Four Bedroom(s) and Elderly Project-Based Voucher** **Waiting Lists are Opening for Multiple Sites**

The Housing Authority of New Orleans (HANO) announces that waiting lists for **studio, one, two, three, and four bedroom** project-based voucher housing sites listed below will open on **January 3, 2018**. This waiting list will remain open for seventeen days. *Please note that only pre-applications from **families who qualify for studio, one, two, three, four bedroom(s) and elderly units** will be accepted. Furthermore, submission of a pre-application does not guarantee placement on this waiting list and placement on this waiting list does not guarantee eligibility or an offer of housing.*

### **Who is Eligible?**

- **The family must be eligible for a studio, one, two, three, or four bedroom unit according to HANO's occupancy standards and definition of elderly (age 62 years or older).**
- Eligibility is based on household income, citizenship, and the ability of the family to meet screening requirements.
- HANO does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, sex, age, familial status or disability.

### **How to Apply**

1. **Obtain Application:** Pre-application forms may be accessed on HANO's website starting on **January 3, 2018**.
2. **Complete & Submit Pre-Application:** Pre-applications must be completed and submitted online at HANO's website - <https://hano.apply4housing.com/>. Assistance with completing the online application will be provided at HANO's office, located at 4100 Touro Street, NOLA 70122. If further assistance is needed, please contact the Special Programs Department at (504) 670-3426.

**Important:** If you are an individual with disabilities and need assistance with the application process please, contact HANO's Special Programs Department at (504) 670-3426 to make arrangements for the completion and submission of your application. You can also call the Special Programs Department if you have any questions regarding this application process or if you do not speak English and need translation assistance.

### **Placement on the Waiting List**

- Pre-applications will be reviewed to ensure that the applicant family qualifies for the housing available for the particular bedroom size.
- If your completed pre-application is submitted by **January 19, 2018 at 4:00 pm** and your family qualifies for housing in a one or two bedroom elderly unit, your pre-application will be entered on the waiting list using a random selection method.
- All applications received after **January 19, 2018 at 4:00 pm** WILL NOT be placed on the waiting list.
- Once you are placed on the waiting list, waiting time is determined by applicant order on the waiting list; the bedroom size required for the household; and eligibility for local admission preferences where applicable.
