- HANO serves approximately 22,000 low-income families through its Public Housing and Housing Choice Voucher Programs.
- HANO's innovative criminal background policy was adopted by HUD as a national model to support formerly incarcerated individuals.
- HANO partners with the U.S.
 Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) through the HUD-VASH program to house veterans. Our program has achieved a 100% utilization rate.

CLIENT SERVICES:

- HANO's Homeownership program is among the largest in the country.
 Since it began in May 2001, the program has assisted over 500 families to become first-time homebuyers.
- HANO's Family Self-Sufficiency (FSS)
 Program helps residents achieve
 economic independence through case management, goal setting, and financial incentives.
- HANO's Resident Opportunities and Self-Sufficiency (ROSS) Program connects public housing residents to supportive services, job training, and resources that promote self-sufficiency and housing stability.
- HANO's Choice Neighborhoods
 Initiative Scholarship Program has awarded over \$300,000 in scholarships to HANO-assisted residents since inception to support college and career training.
- HANO's Summer Youth Employment Program (SYEP) provides meaningful, paid summer job placements for youth ages 14–24, building workforce skills and career exposure.
